



Helmet

The Helmet setup allows for quick, convenient site capture. The camera is attached to the helmet with a mount and riser (can be detached). Start by watching the Inserting the Suspension video, and then come back here to finish.

















When to use?

Use the helmet as the default option for most site captures.


Advantages


- Hands free mobility.


- Danger of camera hitting doorways and other obstacles.









Selfie-stick

The selfie-stick is a lightweight, easy to use option. Just attach the camera to the selfie-stick, and capture the site as you walk.









When to use?


• Use when you need to get into higher, or hard to reach, areas.

Advantages

- Extends up to ~5 feet.
- Lightweight (weighs 0.43kg / 0.95lbs.).

Note

- Keep the camera at least 6 inches directly above your head.
- Keep it stable to avoid motion blur.
